

The Winner Is...

The World Architecture Festival, the biggest architectural event in the world held in Barcelona at the end of last month named Grafton Architects' new faculty building for the Luigi Bocconi University in Milan as World Building of the Year. Speaking at the awards ceremony, festival director Paul Finch praised the building for its relationship with the city. Evaluated by a super jury comprising of Cecil Balmond, Ricky Burdett, Charles Jencks, Süha Özkan and chaired by Robert Stern, the faculty building impressed with it's physical and conceptual density and the "effortless with no histrionics" structural solution that suspends offices for 1000 professors over a subterranean concourse. With its allusions to Modernist megastructures reprised and reconceived for the twenty-first century, "It's one of those great buildings that allows you to see a moment of the past in a totally fresh way" as chairman Stern observed.
